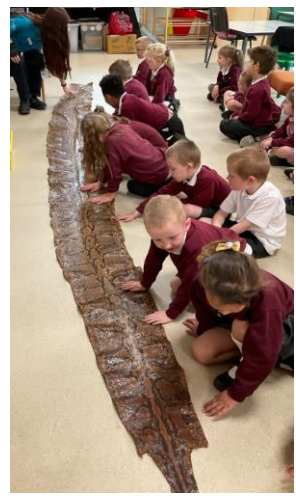
Eloise enjoyed learning about the LGBT community and treating all people equally she went home and created her own rainbow flags for members of the class!
