We have lots of exciting activities planned and new learning to explore this half term. Below is a brief summary of the things we will be covering over the next 7 weeks.

Week 1 KEY FOCUS: Fiction text – Commotion in the Ocean. Understanding the World - Geography; using and drawing maps.

Week 2 KEY FOCUS: Fiction text – Sharing a shell. Understanding the World–Geography; contrasting locations– Partington and Coastal locations.

Week 3 KEY FOCUS: Fiction text – Spinderella. Understanding the World–Science; floating and sinking. Sports day– Tuesday 18th June.

Week 4 KEY FOCUS: Fiction text: Pirates love Underpants. Understanding the World– Science– Forces– how things move– wind and water.

Week 5 KEY FOCUS: Fiction text—What the Ladybird Heard at the Seaside. Understanding the World—History; people who keep me safe.

Week 6 Transition week. Understanding the World– History; My personal history in Nursery.

Week 7: End of term. Expressive Arts and Design- DT week; weaving.
